

## SUMMER CAMP C.I.T. PROGRAM ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

Read below for essential information you need to know about our CIT program, designed to develop leadership skills, responsibility, and a love for camp. Inside, you'll find details on the program structure, training sessions, application process, and more. We're excited to help young leaders grow and make a positive impact.

## **PROGRAM INFORMATION**

- C.I.T. applications open on March 1, 2025.
- Per the State of Connecticut guidelines, a CIT is considered a camper, rather than a staff member. We accept CIT applications for 14 and 15 year olds (as of June 2025). Staff positions are available for ages 16 and up.
- Applicants may select any or all of the 8 weeks of camp. Week selection may be non-consecutive. Once accepted, weeks can be added at any time.
- Regardless of camp weeks selected, all selected C.I.T.s are required to attend orientation training on the following dates:
  - June 23 June 27, 5:45-9:30PM
  - June 29, 12:00-5:00PM (Camper Orientation Event)
  - Additional trainings may be required.
- All fees are due at time of registration. 50% of all paid fees are a deposit for each camp week and only 50% of paid fees can be refunded upon written request until June 20th, 2025. No refunds of any amount are granted after June 20, 2025.
- \$25.00 will be charged to your original billing method for each requested change to your selected weeks. There is no fee for increasing weeks of enrollment.
- To apply, complete the online application. Once reviewed, a virtual or in-person interview will be scheduled with the Camp Director. You will be notified before June 1st, 2024, at the latest, of your acceptance status.
- Once accepted, you will be sent a registration link. Do not register online before you have received your acceptance status.
- Be aware that there are a limited amount of spots per week. Applications submitted after June 1st, will be reviewed only if spots are still available. Spots are limited, applicants are encouraged to apply as soon as possible.
- C.I.T.S are expected to fully participate in any/all of the following physical activities: sports, swim and field trips.
- C.I.T. daily hours are 7:30AM-4:30PM, but may opt to stay until 6:30PM if they chose.
- Daily supplies/gear includes: backpack, sneakers, swim suit, towel, lunch, snacks and water bottle.
- C.I.T.s are prohibited from carrying a phone on their person during camp hours. It may be left at home or locked in the camp office during the day.
